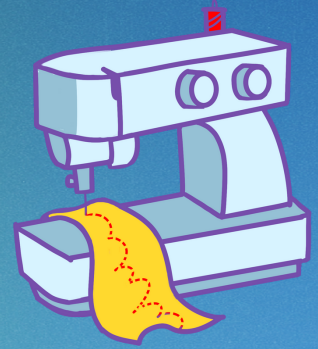


AI TOOLS FOR SEWISTS & QUILTERS

Organize a project	Create a timeline for completing a queen-size quilt in 4 weeks.
Find tutorials	Suggest youtube tutorials about bias binding techniques

Microsoft Copilot	Content creation, question answering	Get help with complex pattern instructions, find code snippets for sewing machines, debug problems.	1. Go to copilot.microsoft.com 2. Sign in with Microsoft account 3. Start using Copilot
Google Gemini	Information retrieval, text summarization, question answering	Research quilting history, find specific fabric types, get summaries of long tutorials.	1. Go to gemini.google.com 2. Sign in with Google account 3. Accept terms and start exploring
Bing Image Creator	Image Generation	Visualize quilting blocks, generate fabric textures, explore color schemes.	1. Go to bing.com/create 2. Sign in with Microsoft account (or create a new account) 3. Start using Bing Creator
