Setup & Calibration

Use a **measuring tape** to confirm your calibration box dimensions — accuracy is key!

Choose the **right projector type** for your space:

- *Mini Projector*: Budget-friendly, needs ceiling mount
- *Short Throw*: Requires less distance, good for small rooms
- *Ultra Short Throw (UST)*: Can sit close to the cutting surface, ideal for flexible setups

Calibrate using a cutting mat. If you don't have a cutting mat — 4 letter-sized pages taped together works great.

Software Tools

Software tools are essential for handling patterns, calibrating, and projecting accurately. Here's a breakdown:

Hardware Tips

- Optimizing your hardware can significantly improve your projector sewing experience:
- **Mounting matters**: Ceiling mounts offer stability, but carts or tension rods offer flexibility.
- **Lighting**: Dim or controlled lighting improves visibility of projected lines.

- **Connectivity:** HDMI cables are most stable; wireless options like Chromecast or Miracast can work too.
- **Projector Choice:** Opt for a projector with good brightness, contrast, and resolution. Short-throw projectors are excellent for smaller spaces.
- **Projection Surface:** A smooth, matte white surface is ideal for projection. Consider using a large cutting mat or a dedicated projection screen.
- **Lighting:** Control ambient lighting to enhance image visibility. Darkening the room improves contrast and clarity.
- **Cutting Tools:** Invest in sharp rotary cutters, acrylic rulers, and pattern weights for precise pattern cutting.
